

## Setting the Top Limit

Please note your motor will come with either:

### Red and White toggles on the motor collar

Using either a test lead or the up and down hold - to - run buttons inside the control panel.

- Run the motor in the down direction until it stops. At this point attach the curtain via the straps provided unless already attached.
- Run the motor up to the top leaving only the bottom piece of the door within the tracks.
- **If the door does not stop at the top press the down button on the panel and the door will stop.**

If the door doesn't sit in the desired position within the opening follow the steps below.

To make the door sit higher in the guides.

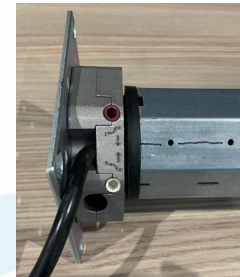
+ the limit approx 5 times, then take the door down & back up again to check if it has moved, repeat until you get the curtain at the desired level.

To make the door sit lower in the guides.

- the limit approx 5 times, then take the door down & back up again to check if it has moved, repeat until you get the curtain at the desired level.

### Left Hand Motor

White is your UP limit



### Right Hand Motor

Red is your UP limit



## Setting the Bottom Limit

Using either a test lead or the up and down hold - to - run buttons inside the control panel.

Please note your motor will come with either:

### **Red and White toggles on the motor collar**

- Run the motor in the down direction until it stops.

To make the door sit higher in the guides.

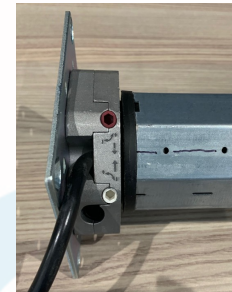
- the limit approx 5 times, then take the door down & back up again to check if it has moved, repeat until you get the curtain at the desired level.

### **Left Hand Motor**
